Regarding the details of plagiarism, the Language Center follows the guidelines of Harvard College Writing Program published as the [Harvard Guide to Using Sources](#).

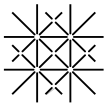

Consequences

A student who fails to comply with these guidelines will receive one warning and have the opportunity, as stipulated by the Language Center, to revise and resubmit the work or to submit alternative work.

Failure to comply with these guidelines after a warning will mean that the lecturer will not accept such work. Under certain conditions this will mean that students do not fulfill course requirements and are not eligible for credit points.
